

COVID-19 PANDEMIC QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

By declaring a state of emergency for the COVID-19 pandemic, Governor Wolf has taken autocratic authority over all businesses in the state of Pennsylvania.

Although both the House & Senate passed a bill last year to make the majority of his restaurant mandates illegal, he vetoed it.

We ARE REQUIRED to play by his rules.

The TOP 6 Rules

Rule # 1: ALL customers and staff MUST wear a mask when not seated {Any time you are standing, you need to be wearing a mask}

Rule # 2: Alcohol can only be served with a meal

Rule # 3: No Bar Seating

Rule # 4: Provide at least Six Feet between parties at tables

Rule # 5: All alcohol sales must end at 11:00pm

Rule # 6: Limited maximum occupancy
